

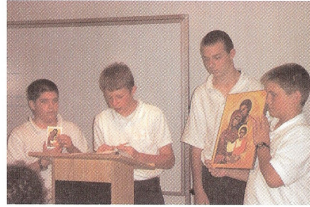

RELIGION

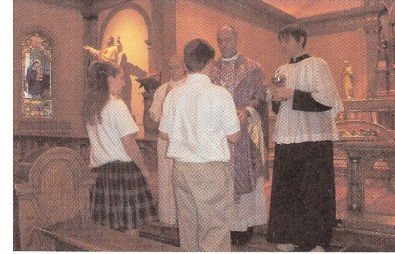


- Students plan and participate in weekly Mass
